STORAGE AND HANDLING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR GORE® CAP LINERS WITH PE FOAM

Gore is committed to providing high quality products that maximize application performance. To ensure the long shelf life of foam liners, the following Storage and Handling recommendations are advised:

STORAGE RECOMMENDATIONS

Foam liners consist of a PE (Polyethylene) foam, a PTFE (Polytetrafluoroethylene) membrane and depending on the product choice a PE/PP (Polypropylene) backing material. Therefore, it is recommended to:

- Store all products in their original packaging in a clean environment.
- Keep the liners stored in a location that does not experience extreme temperatures and temperature changes.
- Keep liners away from hot pipes and direct sunlight.

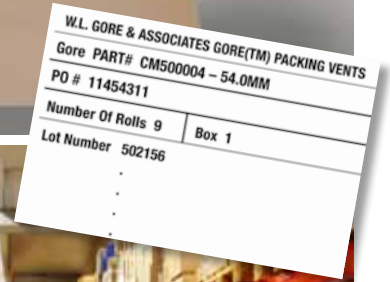
SHELF LIFE

If storage and handling recommendations are followed correctly, the shelf life of foam liners is greatly increased. Independent of the conditions, Gore recommends that foam liners are punched and inserted into caps within 12 months.

HANDLING RECOMMENDATIONS

Please note that the membrane may be damaged if not handled correctly. Therefore, please follow the handling recommendations listed below:

- Avoid touching, bending, folding or twisting the liner material.
- Check laminate compatibility prior to use with chemicals (according to our product information for application testing).
